I recently became a Marabu Artist Educator and was trained then sent all these wonder supplies to experiment with and use in my art and classes. I am thoroughly enjoying playing with these and wanted to share my discoveries with you.

You could certainly substitute for materials you have.

Supplies Used in this painting.

Marabu Aqua Inks

I used the primaries: Magenta, Lemon Yellow and Cyan

(you could use liquid acrylics, watercolors)

Marabu Aqua Pens

I only used orange and magenta in this project. (You could use TomBow or other water-based pens)

Marabu Art Spray (these are acrylic sprays)

I used Raspberry and Lemon

Marabu Acryl Mousse

I used Lavender

Marabu Art Crayon

I used Sunshine Yellow, Chili Pepper, Cherry Red, Rose Pink, Turquoise, Sky Blue, Gentian (blue), and White

Posca White Pen

Optional: Micro Dental Brush

Substrate: I used 140 lb. watercolor paper, but you can use mat board, multi-media paper, or canvas (not Yupo or non-porous surface)

Here is one 10x10 or 9x12. You may want to use a pad or have at least 4 sheets of paper.

Water color brush #8 round (use whatever watercolor brush you like)

Stiff bristle brush for scrubbing. (this could also be an old beat up brush)

Water container

Paper towels

Optional but nice: Aqua Brush
